### Dismissals and Resignations whilst under investigation for misconduct – 2013

Date	Rank	Breach	Outcome
28.04.13	Constable	<p>It was alleged that following the officer's attendance at the home of a vulnerable female, they engaged in an inappropriate sexual relationship with her, abusing their position as a police officer.</p> <p>It was alleged that the officer was not conscientious and diligent in the performance of their duties and neglected their responsibilities when, having been sent a text message by the perpetrator informing the officer of a serious assault, the officer failed in their duty to take action in relation to that communication.</p> <p>It was alleged that following the officer's attendance at the home of a vulnerable female victim of domestic violence, the officer attempted to form an inappropriate relationship with her, abusing their position as a police officer, and sent inappropriate text messages of a sexual and/or suggestive nature. The officer continued to pursue this course of conduct after they had been requested to desist and in the knowledge that the attention was unwanted and that their behaviour was likely to cause alarm, harassment or distress to the recipient.</p>	Resigned whilst under investigation.
24.05.13	Constable	<p>It was alleged that whilst on duty and in uniform the officer, whilst at the residence of a vulnerable female indecently assaulted her.</p> <p>It was also alleged that whilst off duty the officer met the same vulnerable female in their car and made inappropriate comments to her of a sexual and / or suggestive nature.</p> <p>The officer also attempted to indecently assault her. Their behaviour was uninvited, unwanted and was likely to cause harm, harassment or distress to the recipient.</p>	Retired Whilst under investigation.
