**We have recently launched a campaign aimed at raising awareness of the online dangers posed by cyber criminals.**

The countywide 'Protect Yourself Online' initiative will see officers across the county teaming up to help keep you safe from harm, anti-social behaviour and criminal activities online.

As part of the campaign, a dedicated web hub has been launched on the force website where you can easily pick up advice, information and support on a range of topics. This includes child sexual exploitation (CSE), social media safety, fraud and online scams.

Officers from the Digital Media Investigation Unit, alongside the force's Digital PCSO, have recently taken to the hot seat to host a number of virtual surgeries, with others set to take place in the near future. As part of the virtual surgery, you are invited to head online to put your cyber security questions to the experts during a live chat.

Safer Neighbourhood teams will also be heading out across the county to chat to school children, parents and the wider community to spread the Protect Yourself Online message.



As part of the Protect Yourself Online initiative, our first Digital PCSO has taken to the ranks to offer advice and support to residents across the county.

Shevani joined the force in October 2014 as a Safer Neighbourhood officer in Littleover, Abbey and Normanton, before joining the cybercrime campaign.

Similar to a traditional police community support officer, Digital PCSO Raichura will be working closely with communities to offer advice, promote safety messages and reduce vulnerability, however all of it is online.

A dedicated cybercrime Twitter account has recently been launched on the social media site where Shevani sends out daily messages to offer online security advice and support, along with interactive polls for you to test your cyber knowledge.
