## Mobile police surgeries head to Hathersage and Baslow

Police will be heading out on the road to encourage residents in Hathersage and Baslow to share their views on local policing.

Officers will be visiting villages in the area in the mobile police station to give residents the opportunity to speak to them about any issues affecting their community.

The Safer Neighbourhood team will also be on hand to chat to residents about any local issues, along with offering advice to help people to protect themselves from criminals as the darker nights draw in.

This includes ensuring that windows and doors are properly secure, no valuables are left on display in vehicles and how purchasing home security kits, such as 'dusk til' dawn' bulbs and drive-way alarms, can really help to deter criminals.

The Hathersage and Tideswell Safer Neighbourhood Team will be visiting the Oddfellows Road car park in Hathersage between 3pm and 5pm on Thursday, October 2.

Officers will also be visiting residents in Baslow on Friday, October 3 between 3pm and 5pm.
