Jewellery stolen from car after thieves smash window

Thieves stole two bags of jewellery which had been bought from an auction house in Etwall.

The Nissan Qashqai was parked in a car park off Heage Lane, Etwall, when it was broken into.

The offenders smashed a window and took two bags of jewellery, which included gemstone pendants, necklaces, an art deco brooch, gemstone earrings, a large collection of costume jewellery and a King George V silver jubilee medal dating to 1935.

They had been bought at an auction held by Hansons Auctioneers nearby on the day of the theft, which took place at about 6pm on Thursday, June 19.

Police want to hear from anyone with information on the theft. Officers also want to trace the driver of a blue Citroen Picasso that was parked in the car park of the Seven Wells pub.
