We asked: What are the priorities in your neighbourhood?

You said: Anti-social behaviour on Penncroft Drive, Danesmoor.

We did: Liaised with the local Neighbourhood Watch co-ordinators and partner agencies to identify problems and offenders. High visibility patrols were increased in the area and CCTV surveillance was improved. A number of nuisance letters and Acceptable Behaviour Contracts were issued to repeat offenders. We have offered extra support to vulnerable members of the community and organised diversionary activities for the school holidays to prevent the issue reoccurring.

You said: Anti-social behaviour and criminal damage in the Sharley Park area.

We did: Worked with partnership agencies to regularly patrol the area during evenings and weekends as well as looking at increasing security measures. We have also held a number of successful operations to target underage drinkers. Through this work calls for service and the amount of damage caused have been reduced and more members of the community feel confident about using the area. This priority is ongoing and patrols will be maintained throughout the summer months.

The team has recently taken part in a successful operation to tackle nuisance motorcycles and a joint operation with VOSA to encourage road safety along the A61. A number of motorists were fined for not wearing a seatbelt or using their phone while driving and nuisance motorcyclists had their bikes seized by officers as part of the clampdown.
