We asked: What are the priorities in your community?

You said: ASB at Springwood Leisure Centre (includes Oakwood Park/Shelter)

We did: We have carried out the following actions in order tackle this priority.

- Anti Social Behaviour Referral Orders
- Utilised the Alcohol Free Zone
- High visibility patrols
- Utilised CCTV at leisure centre and youth shelter on park
- Regular contact with staff and management at Springwood Leisure Centre helps us identify the key perpetrators and enables us to target our efforts more effectively.

Working together with our partnership agencies including Sporting Futures and PAYP has had a positive impact on reducing calls for service to the area.

You said: Anti-social behaviour - Oakwood District Centre

We did: - Again actions we have taken: Mosquito installed in the area

- High Visibility Patrols
- ASB Referrals
- Utilise Alcohol Free zone
- Utilise Youth Shelter on Park
- Removal of youths congregating around shops
- Maintained regular contact with retail units at centre

Calls for service have reduced and this has been reflected by the number of referrals made to the Anti Social Behaviour Team. We will continue to patrol the area and take positive action where necessary.

You said: Auto crime

We did: Carried out plain clothes/high visibility patrols and distributed crime prevention leaflets. We urge residents to be vigilant in securing their vehicles and removing valuables. With many of these auto crimes, the vehicles have been left insecure making it all the easier for opportunist thieves.
