The Tibshelf and Blackwell Safer Neighbourhood Team has welcomed PCSO Stuart Swaby since our last newsletter. Over the spring period we have continued to work in the community strengthening links with local schools, older people’s groups and youth clubs.

We are committed to providing a high visibility presence around all the villages we serve to help reduce crime and anti-social behaviour.

# We asked: What are the priorities in your neighbourhood?

**You said: Anti-social behaviour on the Charnwood Crescent Estate and playing fields, Newton.**

**We did:** Carried out patrols at specific times when the problems were occurring to deter the behaviour and reassure residents in the area. Any youths found drinking or causing anti-social behaviour had the alcohol seized from them and nuisance letters sent to their parents. We have been working closely with the local shop keepers who have been very pro-active in assisting with this issue. We would encourage residents to continue to call in if they are having problems with anti-social behaviour.

**You said: Speeding traffic on the High Street, Tibshelf.**

**We did:** Conducted regular high visibility patrols both on foot and in marked police cars to deter motorists from speeding along this stretch of road. Speed checks using hand held devices have also been carried out by the team. Plans are in place for a joint event between police and VOSA to target drivers who commit motoring offences in the area. There has been a reduction in the number of speeding vehicles but we will continue to target this issue as a priority.

In other news, we recently carried out a warrant on a house in Blackwell following information received regarding drug misuse. A man and woman have been arrested. If you have any information about drug use in your neighbourhood please call us on the number below or call Crimestoppers anonymously.
