Write guidelines



- Police officers are going to be kind and understanding.



- Police officers will tell you what they are doing and how you can contact them.



- The Police will be seen out and about where you live.



- The Police will get in touch if you leave a message.



- The Police will get to 999 emergencies in 15 minutes.



- If you call the Police about some thing that has made you scared or upset we will get to you in 1 hour.



- Police officers will let you know when and where you can meet them each month.



- Police officers will let you know what happens if you report a crime and what happens to the people who do the crime.



- If you tell the Police about a crime, a police officer will tell you what they are doing about it.

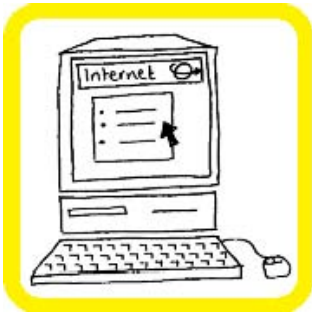


- If you are unhappy with the Police the police officers will find out why you are unhappy with them and try to put this right.
